

Divine Love Baptist Church

4303 Sheriff Road, NE



Divine Love was established in 1984. The Baptist Church is a part of the significant Baptist presence in the Deanwood community given the presence of the Progressive National Baptist Convention at 601 50th Street, NE. It is the priority of Baptist churches to advance the concepts of fellowship, progress, service, and peace.

Divine Love is a red-brick, square, one level building that sits on the Greater Deanwood Heritage Trail; the Trail was unveiled in 2009. Since the 1950's, Sheriff Road has been an important corridor for the African American community, a commercial district that includes a hair salon, grocery, and clothing store. ~

Little Rock Church of Christ Bibleway & Hope for Life Centers

5030 Sheriff Road, NE

The Little Rock Church of Christ Bibleway is a church for all people. The Church's vision is to be a haven for the saving of souls and believes that it has been placed in the Deanwood community to be a light which cannot be hidden. It suggests to

those in the community that one visit can change one's life. The Congregation prays for the restoration of every home and the wholesomeness of every community. Little Rock has a Pentecostal affiliation and offers a worship or prayer service every day of the week except Monday.



Little Rock is a tan-brick, one story building in an L-shape. Stained glass windows provide natural, colorful light within the Church. The Sheriff Road upon which Little Rock resides is named after the Sheriff family that once owned slaves and farmland in Deanwood. Deanwood acquired its name from a Sheriff family descendant by the last name of Dean who built homes in the area subdivisions. ~

New Beginnings Christian Fellowship

4421 Sheriff Road, NE

New Beginnings Christian Fellowship is a Mt. Cavalry Holy Church of America. Pastor Eugene Myles and Co-Pastor Jane Myles founded the church in 1995, having both attended Washington Bible College prior to the founding.

Under their leadership, New Beginnings describes itself as a neighborhood church that celebrates its parishioners, community, and worship. The Church, an interdenominational body, began with just 13 members. The Church has since grown in size and programming which includes revivals, conferences, couples ministries, bible studies, workshops, seminars, and television programming. Both Pastors have been active in the Washington, DC area Prison Ministry.

A quaint, white-brick church with red doors, New Beginnings is the neighborhood church that it describes itself as. Sharing tree lined Sheriff Road, NE with other churches, residences, and small businesses, New Beginnings sits neatly on the block with these other community members.



The Fishing School

In August, 2009, the original structure was torn down and replaced by a new 6,000 square foot youth and parent center for the youth development organization The Fishing School (TFS).



The new facility was constructed in 7 days time by the home improvement reality show *Extreme Makeover: Home Edition!* Tom Lewis, a former D.C. Metropolitan Police Officer in the "Officer Friendly" program, was concerned about the educational and motivational needs of the children of low-income households within the Northeast section of D.C.

The Pilgrim Rest Baptist Church

4611 Sheriff Road, NE



The mission of the Pilgrim Rest Baptist Church is "to exhibit the love of Christ to the unsaved through our

walk, talk, and actions. We will win them to Christ and lead them into discipleship." The Church leader is the Reverend Freddie Davis who has been Pastor since July 3, 1977. Reverend Davis' teaching, preaching, strong faith and vision manifests itself both inside and outside of the church. Pilgrim Rest has over 25 ministries such as the International Ministry which provides ongoing support to Pignon, Haiti and The Better Way Program which is devoted to helping church members, the community, family and friends seek a way to remove themselves from drug and alcohol dependency.

In March 1979, God blessed Pilgrim Rest to purchase land at 4611 Sheriff Road, NE. On Sunday, April 1, 1979, the property was dedicated to the GLORY OF GOD for our new church site. Saturday, May 14, 1983, Pilgrim Rest held the Groundbreaking Ceremony. And on Saturday, June 27, 1987, Pilgrim Rest marched into its new church home, 4611 Sheriff Road, NE. We praise God for His many blessings.

The Pilgrim Rest Baptist Church is a red brick, multi-level building that stands on the corner of 47th Street and Sheriff Rd NE. Sharing tree lined Sheriff Road with other churches, residences, and small businesses, Pilgrim Rest sits neatly on the block with these other community members. ~

**The Holy Christian Missionary Baptist Church for All People
5110 Nannie Helen Burroughs Avenue, NE**

On September 25, 2011, the Holy Christian Missionary Baptist Church for All People (HCMBC) will celebrate 19 years. Also referred to as the House of Praise, the Church is under the leadership of Reverend Stephen E. Young and his wife Elithia F. Young. The first HCMBC service was housed in Zelcy's Banquet Hall located at 4611 Nannie Helen Burroughs, NE, with services later being held at the Progressive National Baptist Church (PNBC) Auditorium located at 601 50th Street, NE. The Church moved into its current home at 5110 Nannie Helen Burroughs on April 1, 2011. Taking pride in its presence east of the River in historic Ward 7, HCMBC was established on the principle that the gospel should be inclusive of spiritual, social, economic, and health initiatives for at-risk communities. HCMBC's ministries address substance abuse, illiteracy, violence, poverty, and hunger.

The Holy Christian Missionary Baptist Church is a contemporary, one story, white-brick building. In this contemporary vein, a modern, electronic sign identifies this church to the Deanwood community. The building that houses the Church was a former Safeway grocery store before it was transformed into a place of worship. ~



NANNIE HELEN BURROUGHS AVENUE Minnesota Avenue NE to Eastern Avenue NE

Nannie Helen Burroughs Avenue is a 1.5-mile multi-modal



corridor that is a part of the District's "Great Streets Initiative". It is currently undergoing \$5.5 million in infrastructure upgrades to include the redesign of the streetscape and roadway configurations, streetlight enhancements, traffic signals and continuing the network for pedestrian and bicycle mobility. Most importantly, Burroughs will be a "green highway" that incorporates the latest in low-impact development features, including tree plantings, permeable pavement, and vegetated filter strips, that will reduce storm water runoff and the urban heat island effect. Projected completion is Spring, 2012.

HOWARD D. WOODSON SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

5500 Eads Street, NE



Howard D. Woodson Senior High School was constructed in 1972 and was the first DC public high school in Ward 7. Its namesake built several homes in Deanwood, including his own at 4918 Fitch Place, for the District's growing middle-class African American population. He worked as a structural designer on churches throughout the city and on sections of Union Station, and served as supervising architect for Suburban Gardens, the African American amusement park that was located at 49th and Hayes Sts. NE. The new 176,658 sq. ft. high school held its official grand opening and ribbon cutting on Wednesday, August 17, 2011 in time for the beginning of the 2011 school year. The state-of-the-art building incorporates a number of sustainable design features and energy efficient systems and includes athletic fields, a gymnasium and a natatorium. ~
