The new building will open in early 2012. The 22,000 square foot, environmentally-friendly design library will feature more than 40,000 books, 40 computers with free Wi-Fi Internet access, 100-person community room adjacent to a new outdoor patio and many other state-of-the-art features. While the new building is under construction, an interim location is open at 4037 South Capitol St., S.W. during construction.</p>	 Complete
