Freedom of Information Act Appeal: 2011-39

Dear Mr. Mulhauser:

This letter responds to your administrative appeal to the Mayor under the District of Columbia Freedom of Information Act, D.C. Official Code § 2-531(a)(2001) ("DC FOIA"), dated June 6, 2011 (the "Appeal"). You ("Appellant") assert that the Office of the State Superintendent of Education ("OSSE") has failed to respond to your request for information under DC FOIA dated April 25, 2011 (the "FOIA Request") and has thereby denied your FOIA Request.

Appellant's FOIA Request sought records relating to school suspensions at District public schools. Appellant filed the Appeal when it did not receive a response from OSSE. On the date of the Appeal, OSSE notified Appellant that it had received the FOIA Request and would provide records on or before June 17, 2011. On June 20, 2011, OSSE responded to the Appeal by stating that, after conducting a thorough search of its records, it had released all responsive records within its control on June 15, 2011 and has not withheld any records.

Based on the foregoing, we will now consider the Appeal to be moot and it is hereby dismissed, without prejudice to challenge the response of OSSE.
