**Freedom of Information Act Appeal: 2012-69**

Dear Ms. Coney:

This letter responds to your administrative appeal to the Mayor under the District of Columbia Freedom of Information Act, D.C. Official Code § 2-537(a)(2001) (“DC FOIA”), dated July 30, 2012 (the “Appeal”). You (“Appellant”) assert that the Department of Youth Rehabilitation Services (“DYRS”) improperly withheld records in response to your request for information under DC FOIA dated June 15, 2012 (the “FOIA Request”) by failing to respond to the FOIA Request.

Appellant’s FOIA Request sought the name, compensation information, and date of hire for “all employees with a title of Medical Officer, Dental Officer, Podiatrist or similar title.” When a response to the FOIA Request was not received, Appellant initiated the Appeal. In response to the Appeal, by email dated August 7, 2012, DYRS sent Appellant a response to the FOIA Request.

Based on the foregoing, we will now consider your Appeal to be moot and it is dismissed, without prejudice to challenge the response of DYRS.
