









# THE DATA IS CLEAR:


FULLY VACCINATED PEOPLE WHO ARE BOOSTED HAVE THE BEST PROTECTION AGAINST COVID-19.

Many people, both vaccinated and unvaccinated, will get COVID-19 in the coming days and weeks. Fully vaccinated people are likely to have no symptoms or mild symptoms. Fully vaccinated people with boosters are the safest.



# #7: CITYWIDE VACCINE REQUIREMENT







Beginning Saturday, January 15, 2022, at 6:00 a.m. certain establishments will be required to verify that patrons ages 12 and older have received at least one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine.

# PROOF OF VACCINATION WILL BE REQUIRED AT:

- Restaurants, bars, nightclubs
- Indoor cultural and entertainment facilities

- Indoor exercise and recreational establishments
- Indoor event and meeting establishments

Exceptions will be carved out for instances when a person is only briefly entering an establishment, e.g., to use a restroom or pick up an order.



# ACCEPTED TYPES OF PROOF OF VACCINE

# ACCEPTABLE TYPES OF PROOF OF VACCINATION WILL INCLUDE:

- CDC issued vaccination card: original or photocopy or photo
- Immunization record print out from the patient portal of their vaccine/healthcare provider
- A COVID-19 Verification App such as VaxYes or CLEAR

Metare GOVERNMENT OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA This month, the DC Council passed the Coronavirus Immunization of School Students and Early Childhood Workers Regulation Emergency Amendment Act of 2021.

Beginning March 1, 2022, all students eligible for a COVID-19 vaccine that has been fully approved by the FDA must be immunized against COVID-19.

 Applies to applies to DCPS, charter, and independent, private, and parochial school students.

Students have 70 days from date of eligibility to get their vaccination.

The legislation also requires that licensed child care facilities must keep records of staff COVID-19 immunization.

Enforcement will begin in School Year 2022-2023.
