PERMIT AND INSPECTION FEE SCHEDULE**



In accordance with Fire Code Supplement, DCMR 12H, Section 113  
(Fee schedule) inspection and permit fees shall be paid as follows:

<p><b>FIRE INSPECTION FEES</b></p> <p><b>Commercial Fire Inspection</b> per site visit and per discipline; <u>first re-inspection of each kind of inspection is included in the initial inspection fee</u></p> <p><b>Residential Inspection (1 and 2 Family dwellings)</b> per site visit and per discipline; <u>first re-inspection of each kind of inspection is included in the initial inspection fee</u></p> <p><b>Re-Inspection Fee:</b> A re-inspection fee shall apply to the third and subsequent required re-inspections due to incomplete or incorrect work per site visit and per discipline.</p> <p><b>Foster Care Home Inspection</b></p>	<p style="text-align: right;">\$150.00</p> <p style="text-align: right;">\$100.00</p> <p style="text-align: right;">\$150.00</p> <p style="text-align: right;">Free</p>
